

SKILLS EVALUATION SCORING GUIDELINE

Purpose

The purpose of this guideline is to provide the evaluator(s) with a guide to aid in establishing consistency in scoring or rating the trainee when using the operator skills evaluation form.

Scoring Options and Definitions

Exceeds Expectations - Performance clearly exceeds expectation for defined task. Operator has demonstrated **proficiency** in performing and or describing the steps or the process for performing assigned task that **exceeds listed expectations.**

Meets Expectations - Performance clearly meets expectation for defined task. Operator has demonstrated **the skills necessary** in performing and or describing the steps or the process for performing assigned task that **meets listed expectations**.

Less Than Expectations - Performance is clearly less than expectations for defined tasks. Operator has not demonstrated the skills necessary in performing and or describing the steps, or the process for performing assigned task. Operator will need additional time to practice this task to obtain the necessary skill level.

Well Below Expectations - Performance is clearly well below expectations for defined tasks. Operator cannot demonstrate the skills necessary in performing and or describing the steps, or the process for performing assigned task. Operator will need additional training to obtain a better understanding and to develop the necessary skill level for this task.
