

## K – BOOM LOADER OPERATING STANDARDS

## LOADER TRUCK/TRAILER

- Loader trucks/trailers should be maintained to approved highway readiness standards for on road travel see loader truck/trailer audit.
- Prior to moving loader truck/trailer on public roads, equipment should be inspected for the following.
- Ensure compliance with highway readiness standards see loader truck/trailer audit.
- Boom and grapple is secured.
- Outriggers are in full upright position.
- Loader decks are free of mud and debris.
- Loader trucks/trailers should be annually inspected and certified by company shops.
- Driver shall be licensed and trained to drive loader trucks.

## K -BOOM LOADER OPERATIONS

- K Boom loaders should be pre-operational inspected (as a minimum) at the beginning of the work day or shift see loader maintenance book.
- Machine should be operated at a safe speed and within the lifting limitations of the machine.
- K Boom loader certification/inspection by company shops should be performed at least annually.
- At least monthly, audits/inspections of equipment components should be performed and documented

   see k-boom monthly audits.
- Operators should be trained for safe operation of the loader.
